

# Costume Party

Finished Size 63" x 74"



This quilt uses fabrics from the *Costume Club* collection by Sheri Berry for Northcott Fabrics.

## Fabric Requirements:

One panel (6648-64)

One 1 ½" strip of each of 6655-36, 6655-52, 6655-59, 6655-64, 6655-74, 6655-99

¼ yard white print with black polka dots (Not in Sheri Berry Line)

1 ½ yards black (6655-99) for sashings, cornerposts, and binding

¼ yard white print (6654-10)

3/8 yard orange (6655-52) for orange border #1

½ yard patchwork print (6649-59) for side border #2

1/3 yard stripe print (6650-74) for top and bottom border #2

1 ¾ yards blue print (6651-64) for outer borders

3 7/8 yards backing fabric (for horizontal seam)

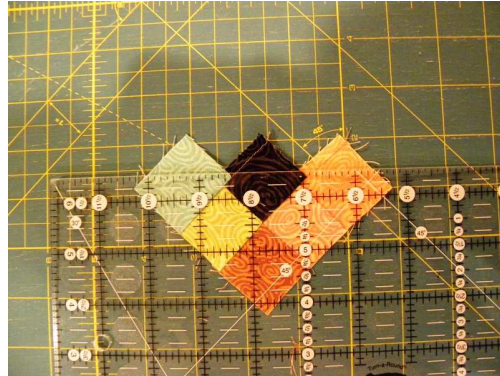
4 ½ yards backing fabric (for vertical seam)

6 1/8 yards black jumbo ric-rac

1. Trim around the main panel picture, leaving ¼" all the way around outside border of the picture. Picture should measure 41 ½" tall and 15" wide.

2. Cut two 2" strips from black (6655-99), trim each to 41 ½" and add to each side of panel.

3. For pinwheels, subcut the 1 1/2" strips of solid colors into 1 1/2" squares. Randomly piece together and trim as shown to make 24 patchwork triangles:



4. Cut twelve 3 7/8" squares from white with black polka dot print. Cut each of these in half diagonally to make 24 triangles. Sew one to each of the patchwork triangles from Step 3. Piece the resulting squares together to make six pinwheel blocks.
5. Cut two 2" strips of black (6655-99). Subcut into eight 6 1/2" x 2" pieces. Sew these pieces to ONE side of FOUR of the pinwheel blocks, and to the TOP and BOTTOM of TWO pinwheel blocks.
6. Cut four 6 1/2" x 9" pieces from white print 6654-10 and assemble with pinwheel blocks to make two units as shown:



7. Add the units from Step 6 to each side of panel unit.
8. Cut two 2" strips from black (6655-99). Trim each to 41 1/2" and sew to either side of panel/pinwheel unit.
9. Cut two 2" strips from black (6655-99). Measure across middle of panel/pinwheel unit. Trim each of your two strips to this measurement and sew to top and bottom of pinwheel/panel unit.
10. For orange border #1, cut five 2 1/2" strips of orange (6655-52). Piece three of these strips together and subcut two 45" strips. Add these strips to either side of quilt. Then cut two 33 1/2" pieces from the remaining two strips. Cut four 2 1/2" strips of black and add one square to each end of these strips. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of quilt.
11. For Side Border #2, cut three 5 1/2" strips from patchwork print (6649-59) Piece together, then subcut two 48 1/2" strips from each. Add to sides of quilt.

12. For Top and Bottom Border #2, cut two 5 ½" strips from stripe print (6650-74). Subcut into 37 ½" strips. Cut four 5 ½" squares from white print (6654-10). Sew squares to each end of 37 ½" strips. Sew resulting units to top and bottom of quilt.
13. For Outer Border, cut two 7 7/8" x 58 ½" strips LENGTHWISE from blue print (6651-64). Add these to sides of quilt. Trim four animal faces from leftover panel piece ¼" around blue or green color block. Block should measure 8 ¼" x 7 7/8". Cut enough 8 ¼" strips CROSSWISE from blue print (6651-64) to piece together and make two 47 ½" strips. Add animal face squares to each end of these strips. Sew strips to top and bottom of quilt.
14. Prepare backing. Quilt and bind. After the quilt is quilted, sew black jumbo ric-rac along seam between border #2 and outer border. Enjoy!
